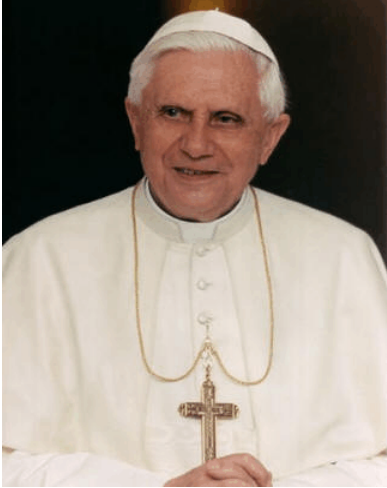
# ITINERARY

## Day 1 - Sun., Oct. 10: Depart U.S.A.

Our pilgrimage begins as we depart on our overnight flight to Rome. Meals and refreshments will be served aloft.

## Day 2 - Mon., Oct. 11: Arrive Rome

After arrival in the "Eternal City", we will be met by our local tour director and transfer to our centrally located hotel, our home for the next four nights. The balance of the day is free.



## Day 3 - Tue., Oct. 12: Rome

A full day of exploring Rome begins with Mass at St. Peter's Basilica. Our guide then takes us through the Vatican Museum and the Sistine Chapel with its awesome frescoes painted by Michelangelo. In the afternoon our sightseeing includes visits to the Roman Forum, the Colosseum, St. Peter in Chains, featuring Michelangelo's "Moses" and St. Paul Outside the Walls. Late this afternoon we will visit with the Cardinal Grand Master of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre (subject to his availability).



## Day 4 - Wed., Oct. 13: Rome

This morning we will experience a highlight of our Roman stay, attendance at the Papal Audience at St. Peter's (subject to the Holy Father's schedule). Join thousands of pilgrims from throughout the world to listen to the Holy Father and receive His Blessing. In the afternoon our sightseeing includes visits to St. Mary Major Basilica, St. John Lateran, San Clemente, the Holy Stairs, the Old Appian Way and the St. Sebastian Catacombs. We end the day's tour with Mass at San Onofrio, the main church of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre in Rome.

## Day 5 - Thu., Oct. 14: Rome

Travel south to Anzio, best known for its military significance as a landing spot for the allies in the Second World War. Continue on to Nettuno, home of Saint Maria Goretti. From there, travel east to Monte Cassino and visit the famous Benedictine Abbey founded in 529 by St. Benedict. Return to Rome.



## Day 6 - Fri., Oct. 15: Rome / Assisi

Depart Rome for Orvieto, home to Italy's most stunning Gothic Cathedral, where the Feast of Corpus Christi began. Continue our drive through the beautiful Umbrian countryside to Assisi, a town which welcomes us in the spirit of St. Francis and St. Clare into its peaceful interior. We will visit St. Mary of the Angels Basilica, site of the Porziuncola, the tiny church in the woods where St. Francis began his ministry and where St. Clare began her religious life. Proceed to the Convent of San Damiano where the miracle of the Eucharist of 1211

took place, the Basilica of St. Francis where the saint lies in rest, and the Basilica of St. Clare.

**Day 7 - Sat., Oct. 16: Assisi / Florence**

Depart Assisi for Siena, home of St. Catherine. Here we'll visit the sanctuary built on the site of her home and celebrate Mass at the Church of San Domenico where she lies in rest. Driving northwest through the beautiful Italian countryside we'll reach our final destination of the day, the "Cradle of the Italian Renaissance," Florence.



**Day 8 - Sun., Oct 17: Florence**

After Mass, our tour of Florence is an artful experience as we take in the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, and the Baptistery with its renowned bronze doors. Continue to the Galleria Dell' Academia to see Michelangelo's "David". This colossal nude Classical sculpture depicts the Biblical hero who killed the giant Goliath. Afterwards, visit Santa Maria Novella Church and Santa Croce.



**Day 9 - Mon., Oct. 18: Florence / Venice**

Depart Florence and drive northwest to Ravenna, known for its 1500-year-old churches, decorated with beautiful Byzantine mosaics. Continue on to Padua to visit the Basilica of St. Anthony. Travel on to Venice, Italy's most colorful city.

**Day 10 - Tue., Oct. 19: Venice**

We'll enjoy a morning sightseeing tour of Venice by foot, first visiting St. Mark's Square (Piazza San Marco) and the St. Mark's Basilica (Basilica di San Marco), built to house the remains of St. Mark. Also visit the famous Doges' Palace and "Bridge of Sighs". The balance of the day is free to explore this fascinating city of islands on our own.

**Day 11 - Wed., Oct. 20: Venice / U.S.A.**

Following breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight to the States.

## GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

**Reservations and Payment:** George's International Tours requires a deposit of \$300 per person at the time of booking. Final payment is due 65 days prior to departure. All prices are based upon a wholesale cash discount.

**Cancellation and Refunds:** Please make all cancellations in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$35 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior, a \$150 penalty will be charged. If canceled 60 - 30 days prior, a \$350 penalty will be charged. If canceled 30 - 8 days prior a \$700 penalty will be charged. No refunds will be made within 7 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets are issued, which will be 35 days prior to departure, 100% of air fare is non-refundable. Additional cancellation penalties may apply depending upon the cancellation terms of our suppliers.

**Travel Documents:** A passport with a minimum of 6 months validity remaining is required of all U. S. citizens. Visas are not required for U.S. citizens. If you are not a U. S. citizen, please call to determine your visa requirement status. George's International is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

**Tour Cost:** All quoted prices are based upon airfares, tariffs and currency exchange rates at the time of printing and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 25 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

**Tour Documents and Tickets:** Final tour documents are mailed, provided we have received full payment, within 3 weeks of departure.

**Baggage:** Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. George's International is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

**Air Transportation:** Air travel is in economy class on Delta Airlines (or any other IATA carrier). Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing and fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice.

**Hotels:** Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms with private facilities. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted and should be requested at the time of booking.
